Long considered one of the all-time great female athletes in York History, Mary (Donnell) Coite was a 4-year starter in basketball and played 2 other sports as well.

- Scored 407 points in her senior year, the first of only four girls to accomplish that feat.
- Twice won the Western Maine Foul Shooting Championship, culminating in a State Championship her senior year.
- Played 4-years under Hall of Fame Coach Larry Lapham and led her team to 4 winning seasons.
- Started for four years in softball.
- Joined the track team at its inception in 1963 and the following year, placed 3rd in the Javelin and 2nd in the 440 Yard Relay in the State Championship meet.
- Recipient of the Myron Cox Award in her senior year as the outstanding female athlete of the year.
