

Richard "Rick" and Joanne "Tautkas" Kenney started girls' soccer in York with a club program in the mid-1980's. They then became the first coaches of varsity soccer for girls beginning with the 1987 season. What they accomplished in 8 years with the high school soccer program makes them a great choice for inclusion in the York Athletic Hall of Fame.

- ➤ The Kenney's compiled a 96-24-9 record in their 8 years at the helm of the York Girls' Soccer Program.
- ➤ In their first year, the Kenney's went 7-2-5.
- ➤ In only their second year, York went on to win their first State Championship with a 15-2-1 record.
- ➤ After finishing as Western Maine Runners-up in 1989, Rick and Joanne won their 2<sup>nd</sup> State Championship in 1990 with an undefeated season.
- ➤ During their tenure, Rick and Joanne helped develop York's first High School All-American, Kristin Briggs, who is already a member of the York Athletic Hall of Fame.
- ➤ In 1992, a third State Championship was garnered by the tandem.
- ➤ From 1988 until the conclusion of the 1992 season, Rick and Joanne's teams compiled an astonishing 60-6-2 record.
