

At a time when all-star teams were unheard of and championships were only at the county level, Dave Lindquist established himself as one of the premier athletes of his time. Playing for 4 years in basketball and baseball with one year of 6-man football thrown in, Dave had one of the most successful careers in York history.

- ➤ A left-handed pitcher on one of the first great baseball teams in York history. Dave lost only once over a 4 year career.
- ➤ In a 7 inning game, Dave averaged 10 strikeouts per game throughout his career.
- ➤ In 1954, Dave pitched and batted his team to York's first ever sectional win over Paris High School. He struck out 12 and went 2 for 4 with a run scored and an RBI. Included in that strikeout total were all three batters in the final inning.
- ➤ Known as "Big Dave" during the basketball season, he often scored over 20 points while controlling the key.
- ➤ He helped the basketball team to the 1954 Western Maine Tournament with a 13-3 record.
- ➤ Scored 18 points in a 55-40 win over Thomaston in the first round of the Class "M" Western Maine Tourney in 1954.
- ➤ Dave also played on York's 6-man football team.
