Niki Taylor is considered by many to be one of the finest 3-sport athletes, male or female, to have ever competed for York High School. Whether in soccer, basketball, or track, her accomplishments and accolades are legendary. Niki belongs to a very small fraternity of York athletes to have won State Championships in 3 different sports.

- Niki played three sports at the varsity level for all 4 years.
- In soccer, she was a multi-year All-Star at the sweeper position.
- As a dominant defensive player she helped secure a soccer State Championship in 2009.
- In track, Niki finished 7th all-time in girls scoring with 364.5 points.
- She was a State Champion in the shot put and the 4x400 Relay, and a 2-time State Champion in the 4X100 Relay.
- In basketball, Niki led her teams to a 63-2 record, winning 2 Western Maine Championships and one State Championship along the way.
- She is the current all-time leading scorer with 1,444 points and 2nd in rebounds with 963.
- Twice named Maine Gatorade Player of the Year in basketball and a two time Western Maine Tournament MVP-Sportsman.
- In addition to earning 3 All-State player awards, Niki was runner-up for Miss Maine Basketball in 2011.
- Her accomplishments were not lost on her teammates as she was selected captain in all three sports...soccer, track and basketball.
